Act 2

LAURA: I came to live with you because I loved you. I stayed because I loved you. (*Pause*.)

I endured you because I couldn't imagine life without you.

(Pause.)

I feel *battered*. Ignored. Belittled.

(Pause.)

I didn't care for you because you're a famous actor. You remember talking about that party where we met? Well, when *you* came over and talked to me - I thought I'd never seen a man so haunted. So defensive and uptight.

(Pause.)

I never thought you'd find me attractive. I never thought you'd see me again.

(Pause.)

When you asked me to, I said yes for you. Not because I was

impressed, or flattered, or anything like that. I almost didn't *dare* to think you'd have any serious interest in me.

(Pause.)

But you did.

(Pause.)

Girls at school used to laugh at me because I said I wouldn't go to bed until it was somebody I loved. *Very* old-fashioned, or whatever. At my school you were considered

freaky if you were still a virgin after sixteen.

(Pause.)

And because of you – I was *glad*. I was happy I'd never been with anyone else. (*Pause*.)

I've been happy with you – but too sad as well. Too humiliated.

(Pause.)

Too hurt.

(Pause.)

I never thought it mattered at all your being so much older. Now I can see it does. Not the years. Not the difference in experience.

(Pause.)

It's that you'll go on being exactly the same.
